About the GTTR

The Graduate Teacher Training Registry (GTTR) is an admissions service operated by UCAS that processes over 50,000 applications each year for around 1,900 full-time and part-time postgraduate teacher training courses at

- most universities, colleges of higher education and school-centred initial teacher training (SCITT) consortia in England
- most universities and colleges of higher education in Wales
- all higher education institutions (HEIs) in Scotland, except the University of the West of Scotland.

We refer to all the above institutions as ‘training providers’ in this report.

Each year more than 25,000 students enter postgraduate teacher training by applying through the GTTR.

On successful completion of a course in the GTTR scheme, training providers in England and Wales award a Postgraduate or Professional Graduate Certificate in Education (PGCE) and training providers in Scotland award a Professional Graduate Diploma in Education (PGDE).

Almost all courses in the GTTR scheme lead to the award of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) required to teach in state schools in England and Wales or the Teaching Qualification (TQ) needed to teach in Scotland.

We do not deal with applications for teacher training courses at any universities or colleges in Northern Ireland. For information about teacher training in Northern Ireland, visit www.deni.gov.uk

The GTTR application process

Most postgraduate teacher training courses start in September each year. Applicants apply from the September one year before they want to start a course. They use Course Search on our website www.gtrr.ac.uk to find out about all the courses in the GTTR application system and then apply online through our website using the Apply system. They must obtain a referee’s reference before they can pay for their application and send it to us. Applicants are only allowed to make one application in each application cycle.

Courses in the GTTR application system specialise in training to teach in primary schools, secondary schools or further education colleges. Applicants can apply for up to four courses, including no more than two primary teaching courses. They list their course choices in order of preference and we send applications to one training provider at a time for consideration. Applicants follow the progress of their applications and reply to offers using the online Track service at www.gtrr.ac.uk. When an applicant accepts an

offer, we do not send their application to any further training providers for consideration.

From mid-March to the end of June, applicants who have not accepted an offer and who have no more choices where they can be considered become eligible to use the Extra process. In Extra applicants use Track to apply online for one further course at a time.

From 1 July, applicants who have not accepted an offer and have no more choices where they can be considered are entered into our Clearing system. Applicants who have not obtained a place using the Extra process are also entered into Clearing. In Clearing, applicants can contact any training providers that still have vacancies on suitable courses. Any new applications we receive after the end of June are entered directly into Clearing.

Applicants who do not obtain a place at the end of one application cycle can reapply for the following year from early September.

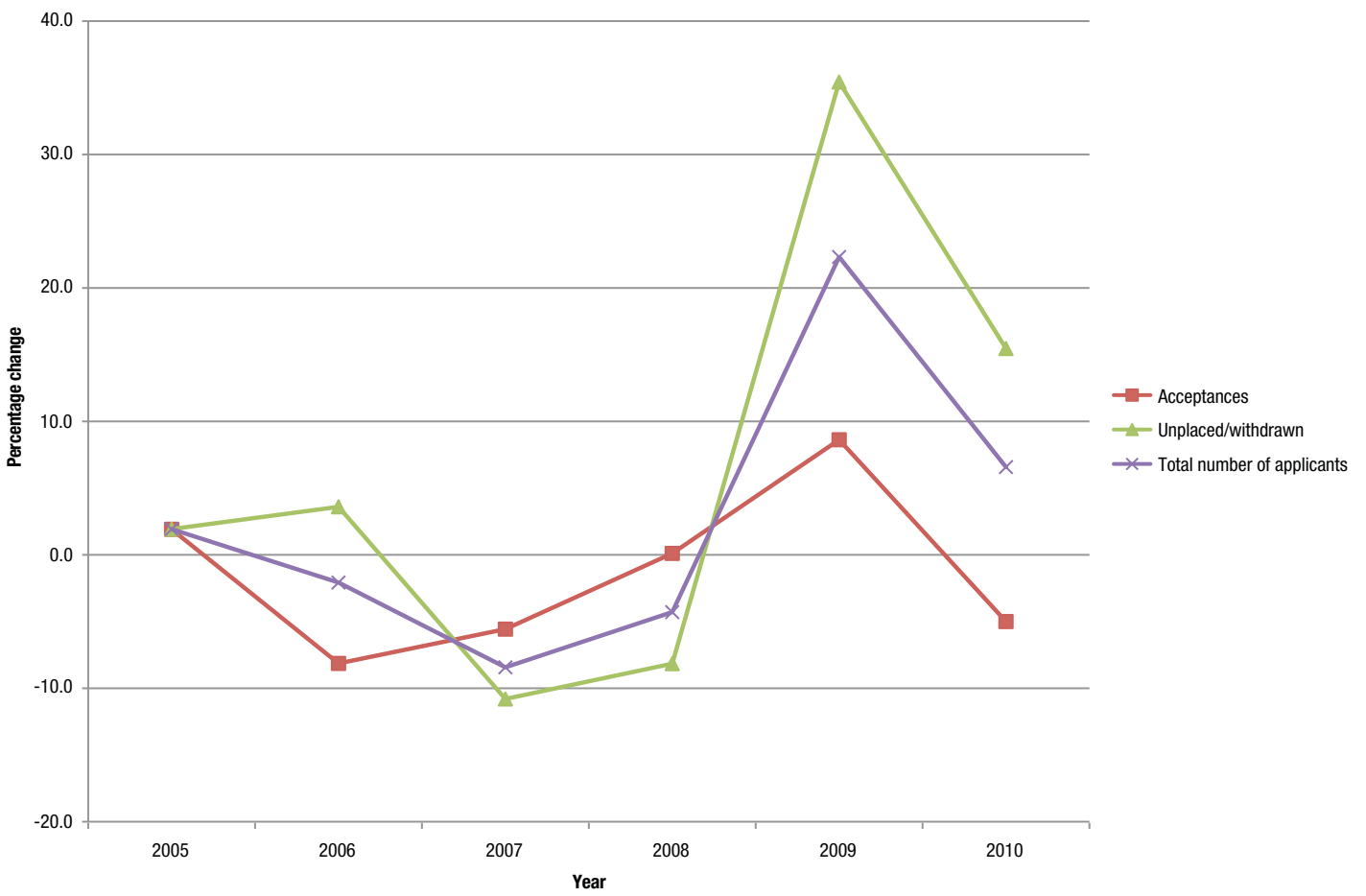

Applicants by gender 2004-2010

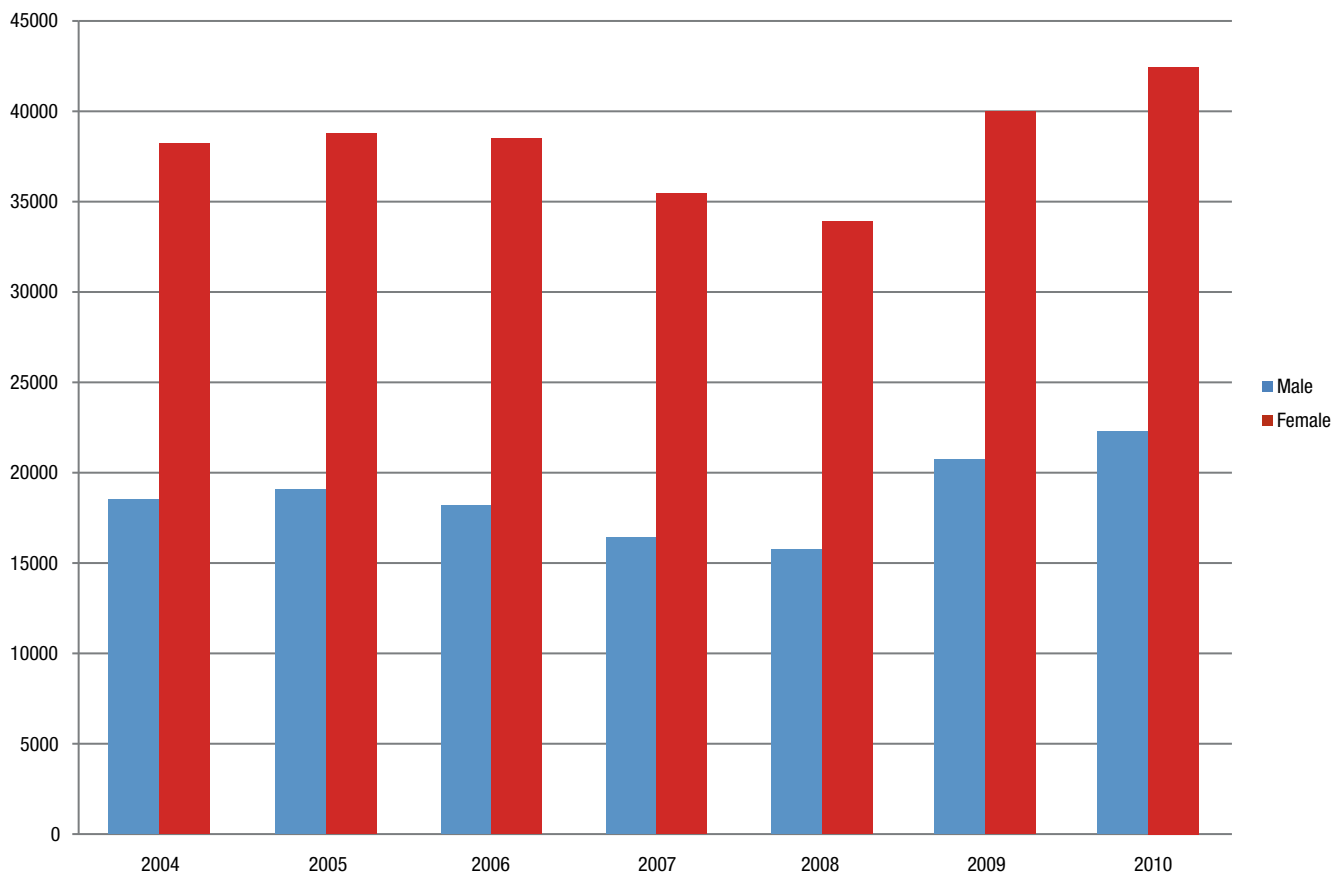

Graph for table A2-1

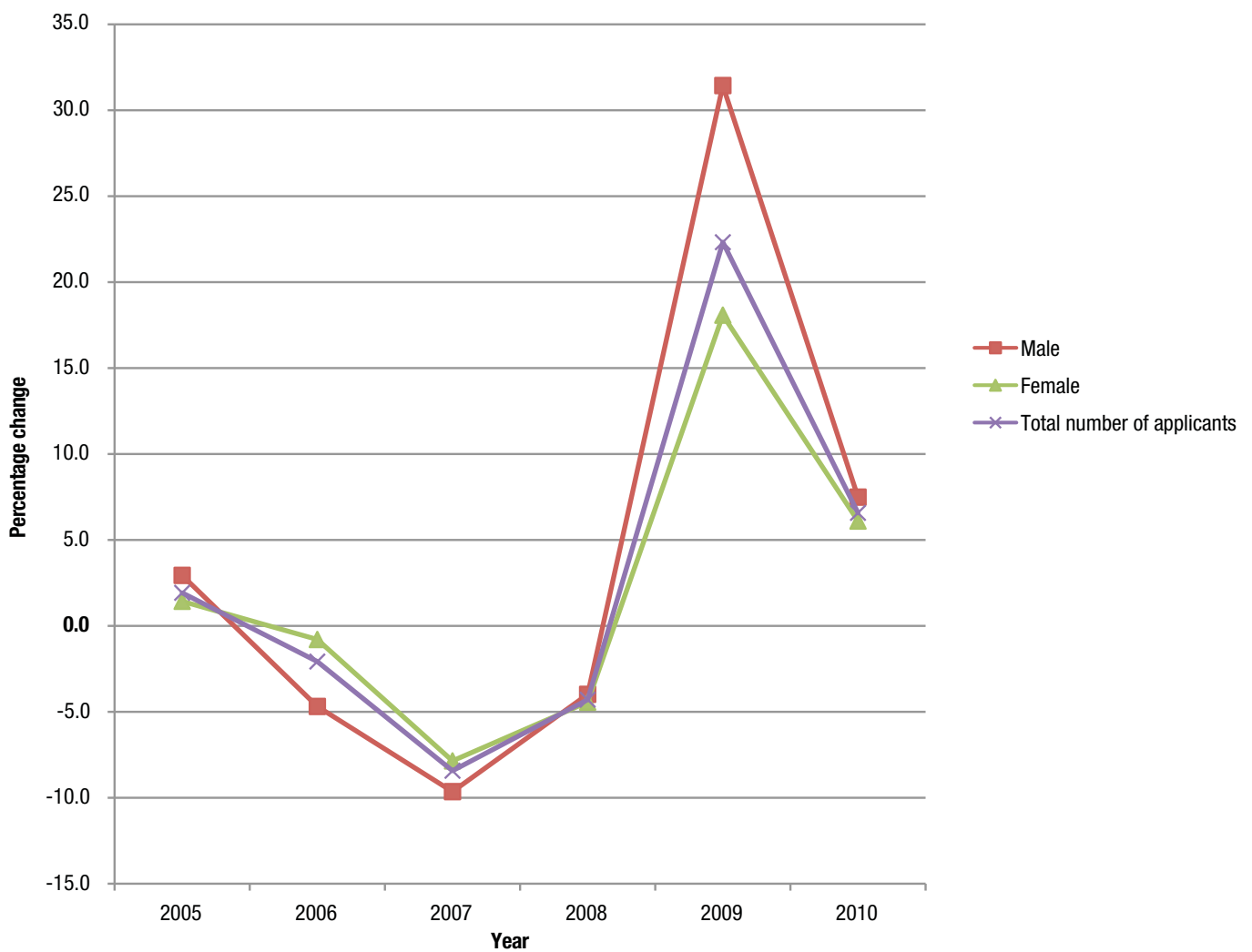

Applicants by outcome

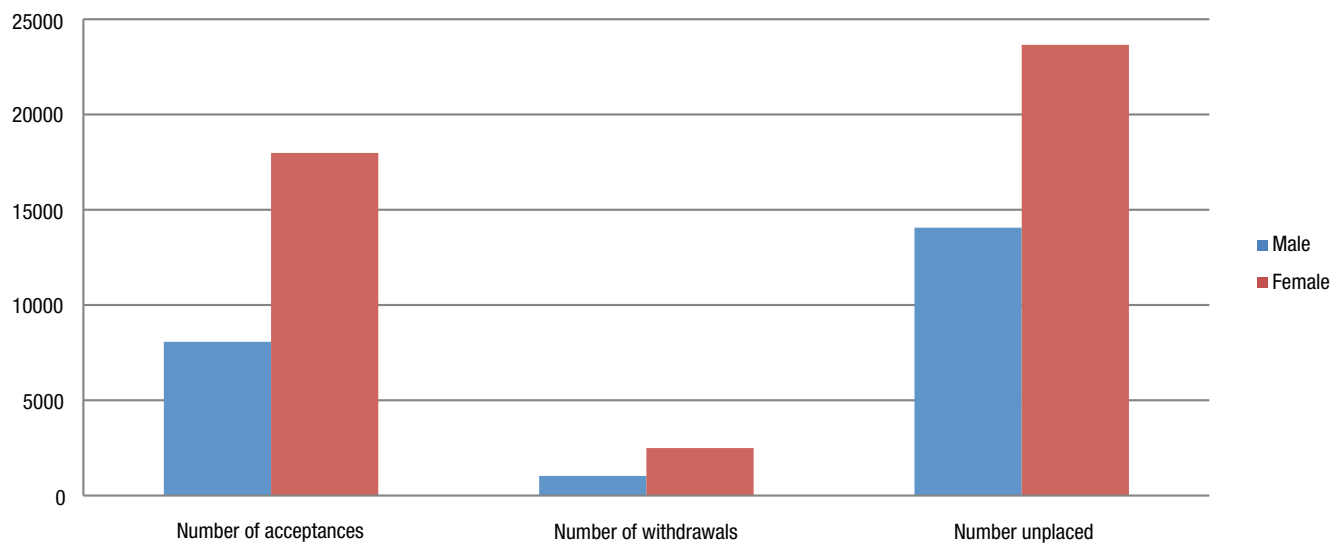
